Center for the Future of Arizona (CFA) has put together a handy guide about the things that the majority of the likely voters care about. These questions are based on CFA's recent 2024 Arizona Voters' Agenda surveys of Republican, Democratic, and independent/unaffiliated voters of all ages that shows what a majority of likely voters across party lines care about most and want to be addressed in the future. The Voters' Agenda only includes issues where agreement among voters cuts across political affiliations and age groups.

What are Your Plans and Solutions? The 2024 Arizona Voters' Agenda revealed strong agreement across the political spectrum on essential issues in elections, water & environment, education, taxes, state spending & long-term planning, immigration, and housing.

The Majority of Arizona's Likely Voters Want to Know

Consider these questions as part of your efforts to deliver on campaign priorities and ultimately create positive change for the state.

-  How will you increase investments in K-12 funding?
-  What should Arizona do to ensure every school has the resources needed to deliver quality education that prepares every child for the future?
-  Arizonans want progress on immigration. Understanding that immigration policy is not solely determined at the state level, what actions will you advocate for at the federal level?
-  In light of broad agreement on the need for comprehensive immigration reform, what steps will you take to create a pathway to citizenship?
-  What specific policies will you propose to make housing more accessible to middle and low-income earners?
-  How will you ensure that state and local governments take a more active role in addressing homelessness?
-  Voters strongly believe Arizona needs higher levels of planning and preparedness to ensure we have the resources and infrastructure to support projected growth and maintain a high quality of life. How are you planning to prepare for growth?
-  What specific steps would you take to implement better fiscal planning and stability, ensuring that Arizona can invest in critical areas like education, infrastructure, and public safety without the constant shifts between budget cuts and surpluses?
-  How will you ensure that all registered voters, regardless of party affiliation, have equal access to the voting process?
-  What specific policies would you implement to better protect our groundwater and secure long-term water supplies for future generations?
